Course Description:

Research has repeatedly demonstrated the effectiveness of the Adult Learning Theory. Effective instructors organize their curriculum in a logical, standardized format which identifies and supports well developed and relevant learning objectives. Moreover, an effective instructor must remain cognizant of the degree to which his audience is engaged. The proficient instructor is one who demonstrates the capacity to adapt his or her delivery techniques to ensure the audience remains focused on the material being presented.

This course will address each of the areas noted above while providing students with an opportunity to place each of these instructor core competencies into practice while being peer critiqued and instructor evaluated.

Course Goals, Objectives and Evaluation:

Course Goal:

Participants will further increase their knowledge, skills, abilities and attitudes with respect to effective instructorship.

Desired Learning Objectives (DLOs):

- Identify, list and explain the essential characteristics of the Adult Learning Theory.
- Be able to explain the difference between child and adult learners.
- Explain the purpose of lesson plans and demonstrate the ability to create an effective lesson plan.
- Demonstrate effective public speaking techniques.
- Identify and list at least 5 different presentation formats.
- Identify and demonstrate basic facilitation skills.
- Identify and demonstrate the use of effective student questioning techniques.
- Explain the Monitoring Process.

- Explain the role and reason for use of training aids and identify three types of training aids.
- Identify and effectively respond to challenging situations in a training environment.
- Explain the value of Evaluation and list 3 different types of evaluation methods.

Evaluation Methodology:

- Students will be required to satisfactorily develop a lesson plan, which satisfies each of the requirements presented in the class. The lesson must support a 15-20 minute final presentation. Instructors will grade the lesson plan Pass/Fail
- Students will present the lesson plan while demonstrating each of the core competencies covered during the course and enumerated in the desired learning objectives section. Instructors will grade the presentation Pass/Fail

Municipal Police Training Academy General Order 8.10

This course meets the requirements under Municipal Police Training Academy General Order 8.10, which requires all instructors to attend a RIPOST certified or approved Instructor Development program within 2 years of initial RIPOST certification.

The Municipal Academy Instructor Development program will be presented by Denis Riel of Spartan International Consulting Group.
