RIMPTA Training Announcement

Traffic Stop Instructor Train the Trainer Course

Program Date: October 15, 16, 17 and 18, 2018

Time: 0800-1600 hours

Location: Camp Varnum
Narragansett, RI

This 32-hour course is designed to take the student instructor through the basic tactics of conducting traffic stops. After successful completion of this course, the Rhode Island Police Officers Commission on Standards and Training will certify the student as a Motor Vehicle Stop Instructor who will be able to instruct from an Academy-approved lesson plan.

The curriculum is designed to assist student instructors in developing, preparing and conducting safe, effective, reality-based law enforcement training and programs, both in the classroom and in scenario-based training. This course is designed to enhance the potential student instructor's knowledge and ability to teach motor vehicle stops techniques. Student instructors will be introduced to, and encouraged to discuss and experiment with, a wide variety of tactical techniques and philosophies in this discipline.

This course is limited to 20 student instructors.

Student instructors must have their Police Chiefs approval and submit an instructor's application form along with a resume to the Director of the Rhode Island Department of Public Safety Municipal Police Training Academy.

The Basic Training Officer and the Director of the Police Academy will review the applicants, which may require an oral interview with each applicant. Student instructors will also be selected based on their availability to return to the police academy to instruct at the basic training program for the next several years under the approval of their Chief of Police. Applicants must also be physically fit to attend.

Students need full duty belts with a training weapon

Patrol level Body Armor

800 MHz Portable Radio

Comfortable but professional looking tactical type clothing

Marked or unmarked police unit from their respective agency.

Foul Weather gear

8GB or better thumb drive; students will be given all the electronic information that is needed to teach this class.

****NOTE: Students are not allowed to miss any block of training and must be present for all classes, mock training and student presentations, NO EXCEPTIONS!**
