DETAILS: The Newport Police Department and Salve Regina University will host a week-long Basic Crisis Negotiation Course offered by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). The training is designed for seasoned law enforcement personnel who will serve as crisis/hostage negotiators. The course is not intended for first responders or executive managers.

The course will be held at Salve Regina University, The Antone Center, 44 Lawrence Avenue, Newport, Rhode Island and will commence at 9:00 am on June 5, 2017 and conclude at 5:00 pm on June 9, 2017. The training includes classroom instruction, case studies, and role-play exercises. Attendees will be expected to actively participate.

The training is offered at no cost. Lodging, transportation, meals, or related expenses are the responsibility of participants and/or their agencies. Attire is business casual. There is no group reservation rate for lodging.

Class size will be limited and interested agencies are encouraged to respond quickly. Response deadline is May 22, 2017.
