Topics to be covered at the training include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Rhode Island General Laws related to Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety
2. How to set up an effective Pedestrian Safety Program
3. How to conduct a safe decoy Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Enforcement Program
4. How to develop a sustained Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Education Program
5. How to develop Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety partnerships within your community
6. How to develop a media campaign to highlight your Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Program

Target Audience: Officers who will be actively enforcing Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety laws with funds from the Rhode Island Department of Transportation – Office on Highway Safety. This training is recommended for officers who are already tasked within their community with Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Programs.
