Work Zone Safety and Mobility for Law Enforcement Officers and Civilians

Please Note: All Law Enforcement officers, and civilian personnel assigned to work zones, are required to attend this training per federal and RI-DOT regulations. **DOT inspectors have been asking officers and civilians to verify that they have been “Work Zone” trained prior to being assigned to details at RIDOT construction sites and federally funded work zones.**

The daily duties of a law enforcement officer can be extremely dangerous, and Work Zones are part of that dangerous environment. Motor vehicle related incidences in Work Zones over the past ten (10) years have led to injuries and fatalities for police officers and civilians. This training has been designed to improve safety for law enforcement officers and civilians assigned to the Work Zones. Objectives of the training include:

- Understand policy standards and guidelines related to temporary traffic control in the Work Zone.
- Understand the role of law enforcement and civilians in the Work Zones.
- Recognize the components of a typical Work Zone.
- Recognize the proper practices and procedures related to the use of law enforcement and civilians in Work Zones.
- Understand the process required for companies to conduct ‘construction’ on Rhode Island roadways.
- Use of flaggers on road jobs.
- Current federal and state regulations relating to Work Zones.
